In 2014, NC ACES continued to build upon the theme of excellence in Extension. Building on our past and continuing to move forward, NC ACES in 2015 will focus on **Excellence, Scholarship**, and **Leadership**.

NC ACES provided several professional development opportunities over the 2014 year. A notable event includes a special listening session held with Extension Administration to facilitate a conversation between Specialists and Extension leadership about Cooperative Extension's new strategic plan.
